 - a. The Article submitted for review is original in the form presented, has been written by the stated author and any joint authors who have granted permission to execute this assignment, and has not been published elsewhere except where this is acknowledged within the article.
 - b. The Article is not currently being considered for publication by any other journal and will not be submitted for such review while under review for publication in the RDD 2012 Proceedings, or ever if accepted into the RDD 2012 Proceedings.
 - c. The Article contains no libelous or unlawful statements and does not contain materials that violate or infringe upon any personal or intellectual property rights (such as copyrights or trade secret rights) of any other person or entity.
 - d. Written permission has been obtained from copyright owners for any excerpts from copyrighted works that are included and the sources are credited in the Article.
